Miniature Schnauzer

Veteran D/B; 3 / 1

1st Johnson & Slater Marmimica Sorcerer. Having judged this boy before he never fails to disappoint. At 10yrs old he still enjoys his time in the ring. Teeth all great and generally still in great condition with the harshest of jackets. Still very sound for movement and no signs of this boy slowing down. Delighted to award best veteran in breed and to see him awarded BVIS.

2nd Parker & McDonalds' Silversocks Scaramonger. 7yr old black male. Again another happy chappie, Good for angulation and very sound on the move, Just slightly taller than my winner.

Minor Puppy Dog; 2.

1st Parker & McDonalds Silversocks Shot in the Dark. 6mth old black male who is really rather nice to put your hands on. For one so young he excels in fore chest with a compact and well put together body. Nice angulations on both front and rear. Lovely for neck and topline. Clean dark eye on super head with well set ears. Lovely expression. Moved well and should have a bright future. Best Puppy dog

2nd Cherryman's Philoma Johnny come Lately. Eye catching 9mth old black with the richest of dark black coat. Neat ears held on a lovely head. Neat dark eye. Excellent tail set. Longer in loin than my winner and slightly taller. Playful on the move but once settled looked good. Puppy dog 1/1

1st Blacknell's Scedir Erik Estrada Na (imp ITA) 8mth Black and silver male. This is actually a really nice puppy. Needs work on the groom and a first time handler but despite all underneath is a right little cracker. Nice head, great ears and neat dark eye. Super for shape. Need to bulk up a little but with support the owner should do well with him. Difficult to assess movement due to novice abilities but he upped the game in the puppy challenge and wasn't ruled out.

Junior Dog; 1/1

Post Graduate Dog 3/1

1st Dowsett's Jillybairn Hot N' Precious. Super little dog, Neat dark eye on lovely head. Well set ears, nice neck into good lay of shoulder and topline held well on the move. Angulations on front and rear were excellent and he had a lovely fore chest. Very close between 1 & 2 but I just preferred the shoulder placement of my winner Res Best dog but pushed very hard in the challenge.

2nd Newman & Day's Risepark Special Agent. Superb dog and presented so well. Lovely to go over, super for spring of rib and depth of chest. Not so keen on the lead today but what I saw I liked.

Open Dog; 3/1

1st Newman & Day's Risepark Star Performer. Nicely sized, well muscled 2yr old male. Good for spring of rib and depth of chest. Noble head with strong schnauzer expression. In harsh jacket, excellent muscle tone well set tail. Sound mover. Would prefer a little more fore

chest but simply could not deny him this class, Best of breed and to see him awarded Res BIS.

2nd Cherryman's Marnimica Mix 'n Match. 20mth old pepper and salt. Heavier set than my winner and slightly bigger for size but well put together. Well presented and in good harsh jacket. Sound on the move and unlucky to meet my winner.

Minor Puppy Bitch; 1/1

Puppy Bitch; 5 / 3

1st Parker & McDonalds Jokerland's Honey Pot. 11mth old pepper and salt who is a delight to go over. Very pretty head not lacking in schnauzer expression. Neat dark eye, well held neat ears. Fabulous for fore chest, spring of rib and depth of chest. Sound on the move. Excellent presentation and a strong class winner eventually going on to be awarded Best Bitch, Best opposite sex, Res best of breed and Best puppy in breed. I later found out she is the daughter of my best of breed winner which was interesting as she pushed him hard for that top spot. As this bitch matures I hope she will go on to do well.

2nd Bisiker's Takoaf Fenders Sensation among Calevie. 11mth old pepper and salt bitch. Lovely for size and shape. Adequate angulations and sound on the move. Jacket needs to tighten and a little fidget on the stack but otherwise developing nicely.

Junior Bitch; 2/1

1st Lewis Avashar One To Keep. 14mth old pepper and salt, Nice for size. Compact and robust, well presented and in good harsh jacket. Nice for angulation and shape but very unsettled on the move. Just wanted to play today.

Post Graduate Bitch; 7 / 3

1st Partner's Deansgate Twinkle Toes. Lovely well presented 2yr old bitch. Lovely shape, beautiful topline and a very feminine head with neat dark eye and well set ears. Handled to her best advantage. Just lacked fore chest and I would consider her to size but worthy of being awarded res best bitch.

2nd Kreigers's Schnaustar Black Pearl. 21mth old black bitch. In good harsh jacket. Super spring of rib but would prefer more fore chest. Bouncy on the move today but settled enough to assess. Very pretty head ,with schnauzer expression and a little bit of cheekiness to boot.

3rd Dowsett's Jillybairn Too Hot To Touch

Open Bitch; 4 / 3

1st Parker & McDonalds Silversocks Sweet Charity with Violis. Very surprising when you go over her. Strong bitch with super spring of rib and depth of chest. Presented in harsh jacket. Strong yet feminine head with neat dark eye and well set ears. Her movement wasn't as strong as her competitors in the challenge
