My thanks to the committee for inviting me to judge the breed at their 90th Anniversary show. A well run show at a new venue which worked very well despite a couple of showers. My thanks to Les Wareham and Elspeth Kelly for keeping the ring in order. Delighted with the super entry of 59 dogs making 67 entries with very few absentees. I must thank the exhibitors for presenting their dogs in such clean well groomed order. I felt that movement had improved immensely since my last appointment.

PD

1st Boultons Boujan's Just Amazing, strong well boned pup with a lovely head and dark eye. Well placed forehead, excellent width of thigh giving him sound movement.

2nd Lockyers Miccosukees Secret Formula, 9 months boy who wasn't happy and did himself no favours. True front with good depth and width of chest. Correct jacket texture, strong sloping topline moving out soundly when he settled.

1st Fish & Moss Invidsia Dios Signore Dulejoes, well proportioned with good body, lengthy neck into lovely sloping topline, ribs well sprung with correct couplings. Expressive head of good length, would prefer more width in his quarters although this didn't affect his sound movement.

2nd McKechnie Yared Alarm Beskyd, dark p/s, masculine head with dark eye, wider in the skull than 1, using his ears well, strong bone with a good rear end and straight tail.

GD

1st Bullocks Ouseview Hot Fuzz, typey yearling boy with a super outgoing temperament. Dark straight harsh jacket, decent neck into well laid shoulders. Well angulated quarters giving sound movement. Would prefer a little less leg hair.

PGD

1st Havelkoas Fit to Fight Grand Calvera, good depth of colour on this well balanced black boy. Masculine head with strong muzzle, the darkest of eyes with a good ear set. Short coupled with a strong well angulated rear and straight tail well set. When he first entered the ring I couldn't get past his profuse coat and furnishings, if this can be managed he should have a bright future.

2nd Wakefields Boujan His Masters Voice, smaller type with adequate neck. Pleasing expression though rather wary, correct bend of stifle, his coat wasn't in the best order and he tended to roach his topline.

3rd Sutherlands Uireda's Lemon and Lime

LD

1st Lockyers Nichi Stradivarius at Miccosukees, a strong powerful dog, masculine head with strong arched neck into sloping topline with correct tailset and carriage. Deep well ribbed body with good bone and angulation, moving very soundly. Reserve CC.

2nd Ladners Dalhambury Kazanjian Red, lovely long expressive head with kind dark eyes. Good length of leg, short strong backline with tail well set. Harsh jacket in good order, just preferred the rear movement on 1.

OD (7)

1st Moores Miccosukees Never Forget at Fillipers, what a super dog, so well balanced. Lovely for size, not overdone in any way. Kind expressive head with good ears, short loin with excellent ribbing and depth, enough chest with correct front and rear angles. Showed and moved to advantage. Handled so well and put down in first class condition. CC & BOB, delighted to see him go BIS.

2nd Lewingtons Zodiac Leebren Grand Calvera, black boy of good colour, another nice for size, long expressive head with dark eye, plenty of depth to body, firm topline with straight tail and set. Enough chest, great temperament moving soundly.

3rd Boltions Ch Boujan Fanny Dango.

Champion D

1st Boltons Boujan Ch Fizzy Stuff, strong top size male with a masculine head of good length and correct ear set. Strong arched neck into well laid shoulders. Great depth and plenty of chest. Strong hammy well angulated quarters which he used so well on the move. Super short harsh jacket well presented.

VD

1st Bawden & Browns Ch Khanate Gin Fizz, well balanced and looking so well for his 9 years. Strong well muscled quarters with short hocks giving sound movement. Neat well set ears, in lovely condition presented and handled well.

2nd Fletchers Fivepits The Mole, another 9 year old looking so well. Strongly made with great depth and strong bone. Correct angulation allowing him to move out well.

3rd Wakefields Khanate Euro Traveller.

1st Railtons Lefenix Keep The Faith, femine puppy with good head properties. Lengthy neck into true forehand, still needs to fill in front. Used herself well and gave a good performance on the move.

2nd Martins Benninghof Its Showtime, black with a good front, bone and well filled chest. Kind expression with dark eyes, strong in quarters, low tailset making her topline look roached.

3rd Bradshaws Kaitweitwei Hijinx.

1st Fletchers Fivepits The Companion Set, good long head with a lovely expression and neat ears which she used well. Good flow of neck into firm topline. Correctly angulated rear with nicely developed quarters. Moved out soundly to go BPIB.

2nd Lockyers Miccosukees Secret Recipe, substantial youngster of 10 months, excellent harsh coat texture, short coupled with ribs well sprung, tail set rather low. She looked fed up and really didn't help her handler.

3rd Coxs Kaiteriteri Kiwi Konnexion

JB

1st Moores Fillipers Going For Gold, lovely femine soft expression with dark eyes and small neat ears. Well balanced with a great rear and short hocks. Dark p/s jacket of good texture though a little patchy. Moved very tidily.

2nd Spurrs Agbelladon Allada, pleasing head with kind expression though her ears were very erratic. Good bone and feet, a touch on the long side and would prefer a more sloping topline.

NB

1st Sutherlands Storms Trail, lengthy neck on this correct sized female. Pleasing head with dark eyes, True in front but needs more filling. Adequate bend of stifle, tail set ok but with a tight curl, moved with drive.

2nd Spurrs Agbelladon Allada.

GB

1st Moors Odivane Sister Act, another typey bitch from this successful kennel. Long clean head with good muzzle and super ears. True front with good return and well angulated quarters. Well ribbed with firm topline and well placed straight tail. Dark p/s with a short well trimmed jacket, went well on the move. Reserve CC.

PGB

1st Bradshaws Gateclyve Aurora from Kaiteriteri, good for type with plenty of substance, I liked her head and expression, ear carriage, depth of chest, topline and tailset. Presented in good coat and moving soundly.

2nd Lockyers Drusilla of Cindy Land at Miccosukees, expressive head but a tad wide in skull with heavy ears. She has a harsh wiry jacket but was just not using herself on the day.

3rd Sutherlands Storms Trail

LB (4)

1st Bullocks Ouseview's Causing Chaos, a lovely bitch with a super outgoing temperament, good head properties with typical Schnauzer expression. Strong straight front with legs set

well under her. Solid well placed neck, excellent spring of rib with firm sloping topline. Well muscled quarters giving strong sound movement. Presented and handled to advantage.
2nd Watsons Miccosukees Guess Who at Jalero, close up to the winner, super for type, strong head, decent neck and substantial body with great depth. Correct harsh jacket, moving soundly.

3rd Staceys Lefenix In the Style

1st Atkinson & Boultons Appleisar Annavayro, bigger girl of good proportions. Strong neck running into well placed shoulders. Plenty of bone and substance with well filled chest. Well presented harsh p/s jacket with sound movement.

2nd Fish & Moss Serenade Alarm Beskyd to Dulejoes, correct for size, good head properties, coat well presented with harsh wiry jacket. Adequate neck with good angles front and rear. Went well on the move.

3rd Moores Odivane Aunt Sally

Champion B

1st Smee & Colemans Ir Ch Odivane Maid for Fun with Schnaubern, oh my goodness, couldn't believe this girl is a veteran, I loved her. Long expressive clean head, neat ears and eyebrows trimmed to show off her dark eyes. Strong true front with well filled chest and a deep brisket. Lovely angles all round, strong straight tail and carrying just the right amount of weight Strong muscled quarters with hocks well let down giving such sound positive movement. CC, I understand this gives her her title, very unlucky not to have gained this before.

2nd Fletchers Ch Fivepits The Detonator, great head and expression on this showy bitch. She has a clean neck running into well place shoulders, strong bone with good muscleing to her quarters. Disliked her curly tail but non the less a very worthy Champion.

3rd Lewingtons Int Ch Oshea Khagrass at Leebren

1st Smee & Colemans Ir Ch Odivane Maid for Fun with Schnaubern

2nd Watsons Ch Jalero Miss lowher, so very typical, good head properties with the required Schnauzer expression, deep well sprung ribs, strong bone, correct angles with prominent forechest, harsh banded jacket, went well on the move.

3rd Boltons Boujan Independent Climax

1st Spurrs Schastivaja Zvezda Hitraja Bestija, pleasing head with a well textured jacket. Deep in chest but her tailset drops away.
